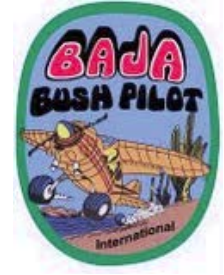


BBP APIS Manifest, a print screen example....



When you have completed your manifest, it submits to the countries that were selected

Once you have completed this manifest, you will receive two email, one from the US confirming they have received your manifest and the second from the BBP with the authorization from Mexico that your manifest has been transmitted. With these two email, you are set to go.

Step 1, Set up your flight.

Note that you have a library that you can draw from as well as you can reverse your manifest.
