



Join the Baja Bush Pilots on their annual “Pet a Whale” adventure. Four days of fun, excitement, whale petting, and for a new and exciting venue, we will be based out of one of the nicest and newest resort hotels in Loreto Bay, the “Loreto Bay Golf Resort and Spa”. But more about the Resort later.



Every year, all get a chance to see these whales as large as “greyhound buses” wrapped in Rubbermaid swimming all around them and most get to touch, feel, pet, and perhaps, even kiss a one. The BBP will be there and so will the Whales....

For those that are looking for more, We are based at the

Loreto Bay Golf Resort and Spa and it is just what its name implies. Located on one of the biggest, whitest, and cleanest bays in Baja, as a part of our deal with the Resort, they are offering use of Bicycles, Kayaks, Snorkel Gear, Paddle Boards, Tennis, and, oh my gosh, ping pong at no charge. And they also rent scooters and cars on property.

If golf is your thing, Green fees for 18 holes are \$68 dollars and you can rent clubs and carts or drive balls at reasonable prices.

If the spa is your thing (trust me on this one) the Resort does it all including deep, hot stone, neck & back, legs & feet as well as Pedicure & Manicure. Want to do a couples massage, it can be done. And the prices are reasonable. I did a full body, pedicure, and manicure that was only US\$100 including a nice tip.

And, as the Bay is shallow, surf playing, walking, swimming, and more is very easy and safe.





Upon arrival at the Loreto airport, you will receive information on things to do and places to go, your nametags, and a coupon book which will provide transportation to and from your hotel, breakfasts, whale watching, and more. Rooms will be assigned in the order that trip registrations are received. As our Resort is of a good size, we will not have to use a secondary hotel for additional rooms.

Regarding the whale petting experience, we cannot send everyone over to the camp on the same day so half go over on Friday and the other half goes over on Saturday.

This is how it works.

Thursday, February 23

Arrive Loreto International where, as last year, the BBP will be there to take care of (almost) every arrival step including parking, fuel, entrance papers, customs, immigration, transportation as well as handle your payment for most fees. We have had our meetings with all the authorities at the airport and the common goal is to get you through the whole check-in process as quickly as possible.



As in the past, all radio communication with Loreto Tower will be by using your "Baja Number" i.e. Loreto Tower, Baja 12 is inbound for landing.

Your arrival day is wide open and could be a time to look through your packet, make plans for the following day, take a dip in the pool or ocean, do a quick round of 9, or just relax. For dinner that night, to make it really simple, quick, and easy, and because people and staff don't have a set dinner hour, we are keeping the tradition of "unlimited" pizza. Always popular and informal, This is a great time to meet and greet others as we chow down on some really great pizza.

Friday, February 24.

Breakfast will be buffet at the hotel. Those petting whales that day will go out to the airport where your flight plans have already been filed and you are ready to depart. Those going to Whales on Saturday will have all day to do the “Resort thing” or jump into a cab and do “downtown Loreto. Friday evening we will have our Friday Night Mexican Fiesta on the Beach with food, entertainment, drawings, prizes, slides, music, and lots more.



Saturday, February 25

Again, breakfast will be at the hotel and those scheduled for Saturday whales will do the airport “fly to the whale camp” thing while those that did Whales on Friday will get their chance to do what others did on Friday. Friday’s dinner is on your own. You have your

choice of eating at one of the three restaurants on property (one being a sports bar) or group up and cab it to Loreto where there are an abundance of places including the La Palapa, one of our favorite fish and steak places.

Sunday, February 26

Sunday is departure day for most. As in the past, most will head home and some will spend more time in Loreto, head south, or head to Mainland Mexico.

Four days, three nights of fun, flying, storytelling, whale petting, food, drink, sun, beach, golf, and more....

Your package will include your room for three nights, all your breakfasts, pizza Thursday night, the Friday night Mexican Fiesta, the whale petting trip and a whole bunch of fun, and more.
